All Boats entering the Tournament are required to have current Boat insurance. * Details of such insurance must be completed on the entry form along with a photocopy of your insurance certificate. Should a Boat not have insurance, nor be able to supply evidence of insurance and certificate prior to the commencement of the Tournament, that Boat shall be excluded from participating in the Tournament. All on-board safety remains the responsibility of the Skipper/Owner.

Weather

In the event of a strong wind warning being issued before the start of fishing for either day of the Tournament, that day's fishing will be cancelled. If a strongwind warning is issued during a fishing day the Tournament Committee reserve the right to cancel/amend that day's fishing program. Notification will be broadcasted on VHF Channel 82. Tournament results will be awarded if, at a minimum, 6 hours of fishing is achieved. If due to bad weather the Tournament is cancelled on all days, it will be re-scheduled. If you are unsure if a day's fishing has been cancelled, please contact Game Base on VHF Channel 82 or call Ash Haigh on 0421 394 208.

Fishing Rules & Methods - Minimum of 8kg

GFAA Rules will apply. Anglers, Skippers and Crew (any person involvedvbin affecting a Tag & Release or capture) must be a current financial fishing member of a Club affiliated with QGFA or GFAA.

Live bait may be collected prior to start fishing and use of teasers is allowed prior to start fishing. Non off set Circle hooks must be used for live baiting and dead baits.

ALL boats are required to provide photographic/video evidence of ALL Tagged & Released fish to Game Base. The photograph/video must clearly show **the fish, date & time and the coloured armband**. Armband will be provided at checkin. Photograph/video evidence must clearly constitute the tag & release of a billfish. Blurred photos and ambiguous shots will not be counted and may result in the disqualification of the billfish.All hookups and weight estimates for the heaviest billfish must be reported to Game Base. ALL tackle used in capture or tag & release must be ready for presentation to weigh station officials together with the Angler i.e. the rod & reel, line, hook(s), terminal tackle, gaff(s), tail rope(s) etc. at the time sked sheets are presented. Any fish tagged/released or captured with nonregulation GFAA requirements will be disqualified from the Tournament.

Please note: Gear presented as that used per fish is deemed the correct one and cannot be changed/substituted.

The Tournament Committee reserves the right to refuse any team or individual Angler's team entry. The Tournament Committee also reserves the right to place an observer on any Boat throughout the Tournament at random.

ONLY NSW DPI "Billfish Only" tags are to be used for Billfish to be eligible for tag points. No points will be awarded where wrong tags are used. Tag cards are to be issued by your own Club.

Fishing Area:

Between 27-20' to the North and 28-22' to the South, and all Oceanic Waters in between.

For Billfish to be weighed for heaviest billfish the estimated weight and short length of the Billfish must be relayed to Game Base immediately. This is to limit the unnecessary capture of fish. **NOTE:** No tag and release points are awarded to a captured fish unless claiming for a QLD, NSW or Australia Record. All carcasses must be gutted and disposed of a minimum of 5 nautical miles from the Seaway as soon as practicable after the weighing.

Radio Skeds

All Boats **MUST** have a working VHF radio to compete in the Tournament. The skeds will be on Channel 82. In a situation that a Boat is unable to contact base via VHF they must make a confirmed relay through another Boat or make confirmed contact via mobile phone on 0421 394 208. Failure to contact Game Base on two successive skeds shall result in disqualification of the day's results. A Boat logging off with Game Base for the day (even before cease fishing) will be deemed as no longer fishing within the Tournament for that day and there are no longer eligible to score points from fish caught after doing so. It is compulsory to log on and log off with Game Base and get acknowledgement from Game Base. For safety reasons we strongly advise all Boats log on/off with the Seaway Tower on VHF 73.

All Boats are to report Tagged Billfish immediately with Game Base to be allocated the time of Tagging, or relay with another Boat. The tag time for the Fish will be the time provided by Game Base after the information was received.

If any Boat is unable to fish, it is a requirement that Game Base is notified by radio on VHF Channel 82 or via Mobile on **0421 394 208**. Captures and Tags not reported via radio sked shall not be counted in the point score and eligible for trophies.

ALL Boats are to report on **EVERY** sked.

DAILY RESULTS: To be accepted for Point Score

 ALL Tag Cards, ActivitySheets, Photo/Video Evidence must be presented to Game Base

 Rods/Tackle must be presented to the Recorder at the Weigh Station

 Fish to be Weighed must be presented to the Weigh Master at Game Base

Failure to do ANY or ALL the above, before Game Base is closed, will result in NIL allocation of points.

Overtime

Restricted Overtime will be available for all Fish hooked up after the last sked and reported to Game Base prior to cease fishing. However, all tags and equipment must be presented by the Game Base before closing time to be considered in the results of the Tournament.

Tournament Conduct

The Tournament Committee reserves the right at any stage of the competition (before, during or after) to effect, disqualify or deduct points from individuals or teams who are deemed to have conducted themselves in a disrespectful manner and are deemed to have brought the sport of Game Fishing or the Tournament into disrepute. In the event an Angler or team of Anglers/Crew/Skipper are ejected, no result or refund will be entered into.

Disputes

Must be submitted in writing and presented to the Tournament Committee on the day in question, no later than 6.00pm. The Committee's decision will be final. The Tournament Committee has the right to act on any breach of Tournament Rules whether a protest has been lodged. Where a dispute is lodged a dispute Committee will consist of at least three GCGFC Inc. Committee Members.
