

# Lucinda Light Tackle Tournament "Malcolm Florence Memorial" ONE DAY SHOOT OUT ~ 11 OCTOBER 2025 NOMINATION FORM

Tournament Date: SATURDAY 11TH OCTOBER, 2025

Entry Fee: The entry fee is \$60 per junior and \$120 per senior. Refer to the following page for the payment process.

Fee includes dinner on Saturday at the Lucinda Hotel.

Venue: This tournament and all official functions associated with it will be conducted from the Lucinda Hotel.

Registrations: Anglers will be required to register no later than Friday 10th October (prior to briefing).

**Dinner & Presentation:** 

Dinner commences on Saturday 11 October at 6.30pm at the Lucinda Hotel and presentation will take place

after Dinner.

## **TOURNAMENT RULES**

#### **FISHING RULES:**

GFAA rules will apply to this tournament and all billfish tagged must be with the NSW DPI tag only. Ingham Rod and Reel Club boundaries apply.

## **LINE CLASS:**

Base Points for Billfish—light tackle only, boundary as per marked line 146.30°E to Pith Reef to 19. 00°S.on supplied map

## **ANGLERS, CAPTAIN & CREW:**

ALL competing anglers, captains and crew must be a financial member of a club affiliated with the QGFA or GFAA. Non-members may apply for associate membership to the INGHAM ROD AND REEL CLUB inc. for the purpose of this tournament - Cost \$40.

## **TEAM SIZE:**

Teams are to be no less than TWO and no more than FOUR anglers.

## **GAME SPECIES:**

This tournament is open to all recognized saltwater game fish species (excluding sharks). Each angler is allowed to weigh a maximum of FIVE fish with no more than ONE of each species. Fish must weigh half of the line class that they were caught on to be eligible.

**BRIEFING:** Friday evening, 7.30 pm at the Lucinda Hotel.

## **FISHING TMES:**

Saturday 6.00am - 4.30pm. Cease fishing will be called by a nominated vessel - as advised in briefing.

WEIGH-IN & SCORE CARDS: Saturday between 5.00 pm - 6.00 pm at the Lucinda Hotel.

## **COMPETITOR SAFETY:**

All competitors must be always personally responsible for their own safety. Boat owners must have their own insurance and be responsible for their own safety as well as the safety of those with them.

## (QGFA MANDATORY RULES)

## **BOAT INSURANCE:**

All boats nominating to fish the Tournament are required to have current boat insurance. Details of such insurance must be completed on the nomination along with a photocopy of your insurance certificate. Should a boat not have insurance, nor be able to supply evidence of insurance and certificate prior to the commencement of the tournament, that boat shall be excluded from participating in the tournament. All onboard safety remains the responsibility of the owner/skipper.

## **DISPUTES**

A Dispute Committee comprising members from a minimum of three clubs (where possible the tournament club and two other clubs should form any protest committee and if possible, the clubs forming the protest committee should not include a club that the protested or protestor are members of) will hear any protests provided they are submitted in writing in accordance with tournament rules for disputes. The committee's decision will be final, and no further discussion will be entered into.

## **TOURNAMENT CONDUCT**

The tournament committee reserves the right at any stage of the competition to eject, disqualify or deduct points from individuals or teams who are deemed to have conducted themselves in a disrespectful manner and are deemed to have brought the sport of Game fishing or the tournament into disrepute. In the event that an angler, or a team of anglers/crew/skipper are ejected no result or refund of fees will be entered into.

## **RADIOS**

All competing vessels must carry a VHF radio in good working order. All competing vessels must remain contactable at all times via radio or agreed alternative communication, by either Game Base or another vessel. Failure to maintain contact may result in team disqualification. A boat logging off from Game Base for the day (even before cease fishing) will be deemed as no longer fishing within the tournament for that day and thereby no longer be eligible to score points for fish caught after doing so. (This does in no way mean a boat may not log on with Marine Rescue Services for safety purposes).

## **POINTS SCORING**

- 1. Points scoring is governed by GFAA rules.
- 2. All game fish must be half line class or better to be eligible for weighing, or equal to or greater than line class to claim a record. Each angler is allowed to weigh a maximum of FIVE fish with no more than ONE of each species. Fish must weigh half of the line-class used to capture the fish to be eligible.
- 3. All billfish to be tagged and released. A bonus 100 points will be awarded for fish previously tagged and a bonus 50 points for any billfish tagged on circle hooks.
- 4. The formula for calculating points:

<u>Fish Weight x 100</u> = Points Line Class LIGHT TACKLE 6kg - 2000 points 8kg - 1500 points 10kg-1000 points

e.g.,  $\frac{12 \text{kg x } 100}{6 \text{kg line}} = 200 \text{ points}$ 

- 5. FOR ANY POINTS TO BE ELEGIBLE TAG CARDS must be correctly completed in full, legible, and handed in with score sheets. Score cards must also be completed in full and legible.
- 6. All fish brought in to be weighed, must be gilled, gutted and in edible condition. No mutilated fish will be accepted.
- 7. The weigh master and judge's decision are final.

## **AWARDS**

- Champion Team Overall / Champion Team Runner Up
  - Champion Angler / Champion Angler Runner Up
  - Champion Lady Angler / Champion Junior Angler
- Highest Point Scoring Mackerel / Encouragement Award
  - Highest Point Scoring Other Game Fish
